



## Terms & Conditions for Cancer Australia/WCRFI awarded grants

- Project grants will be awarded according to the following core principles:
  - (i) applications will have been submitted through WCRFI Regular Grant Programme
  - (ii) Peer-review using WCRFI's multi-step and merit-based process, and merit-based allocation of funding
  - (iii) Co-funding (50:50) by Cancer Australia and WCRFI of cancer research project grants to Australian researchers based in Australia;
  - (iv) Funding of primary cancer prevention and survivorship research which aligns with research priorities of CA and WCRFI.
- Grant holders will sign separate Terms & Conditions (T&Cs) agreements with Cancer Australia and WCRFI.
- Funding for individual grants will be up to £100,000 per year for up to 3 years, for a total maximum of £300,000. Grants will be co-funded 50:50 by WCRFI and Cancer Australia:
  - Cancer Australia will award in Australian dollars. The exchange rate will be set at the time the grant is awarded and it is this commitment which will be honoured by Cancer Australia. Payments will be made on execution of the funding agreement, and after receipt and acceptance of annual reports.
  - o WCRFI will award in pounds sterling or euros in arrears on a monthly basis as per WCRFI T&Cs. The monthly payment will be subject to any fluctuations in the exchange rate when the payment is converted to AUD. These fluctuations will be at the Institution's expense or gain.
- Grant holders must provide copies of progress reports in-confidence to WCRFI.
  Finance reports will need to be provided separately to Cancer Australia and WCRFI.
- Grant holders must notify both parties regarding any new outcome arising from the funded grants (i.e. conference presence, abstracts, publications).
